CLIMATE CHANGE IMPACT ASSESSMENTS

- Help the Council understand, assess and respond to climate impacts
- Ensure environmental considerations are integrated into decision-making
- Mandatory to be considered for Cabinet Reporting from **August 2026**.

AIMS:

- To support decision makers
- understand & reduce negative impacts
 - minimised, mitigated or modified
- Reduce the Council's Carbon Footprint

 Capture positive outcomes too!

CLIMATE CHANGE IMPACT ASSESSMENTS

TWO STEP PROCESS:

SCREENING TOOL

- Quick & Easy
- Understand if any potential impacts



FULL ASSESSMENT (CCIA)

- If required after screening tool
- Simple, easy to use tool to detail potential impacts
- Mitigations, justifications or opportunities
- Input into Cabinet Report

COUNCIL CLIMATE ACTION SCORECARD 2025

- Climate Emergency UK
- Marked by volunteers
 - National data sets
 - FOIs
 - Volunteer research

Increased by 10% since the last scorecard

RBC will not be reassessed for 2027 due to LGR.

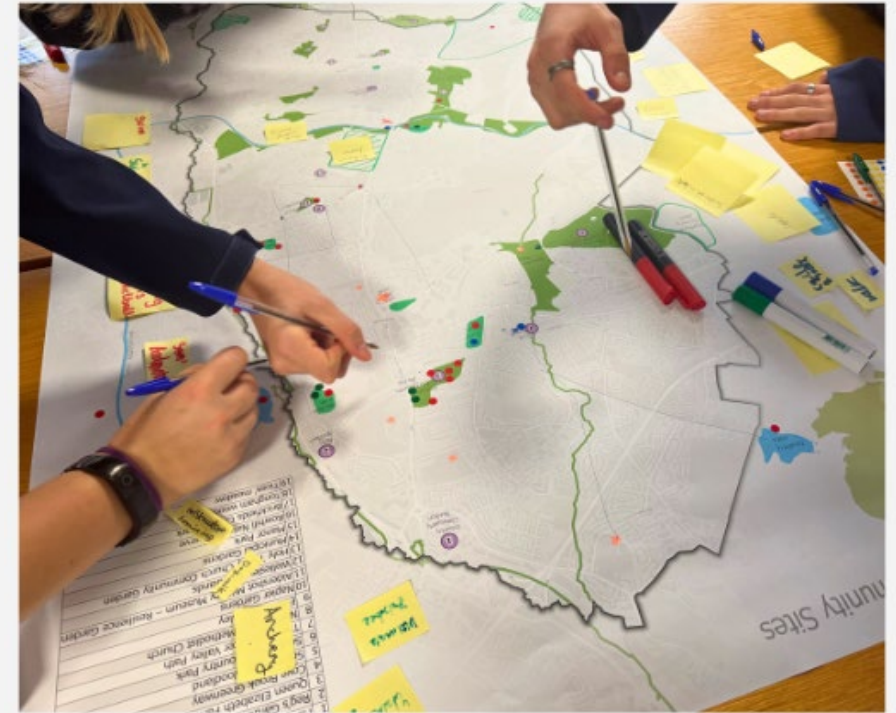

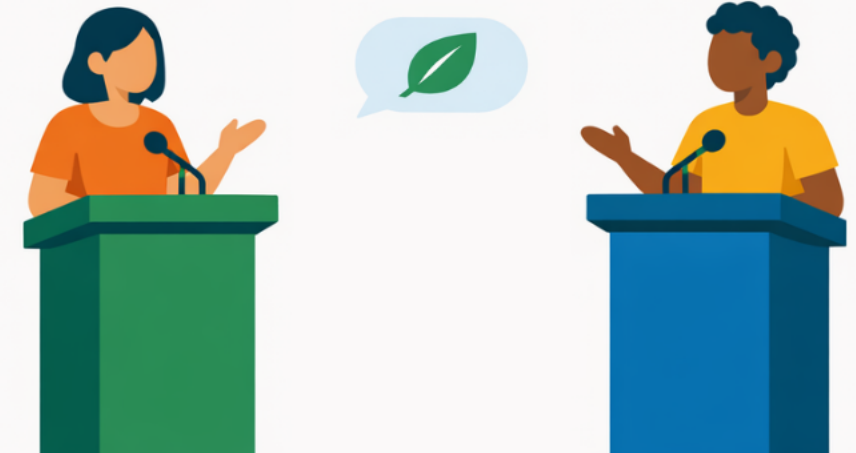

- Linking to persuasive argument, public speaking, critical thinking & the democratic process.

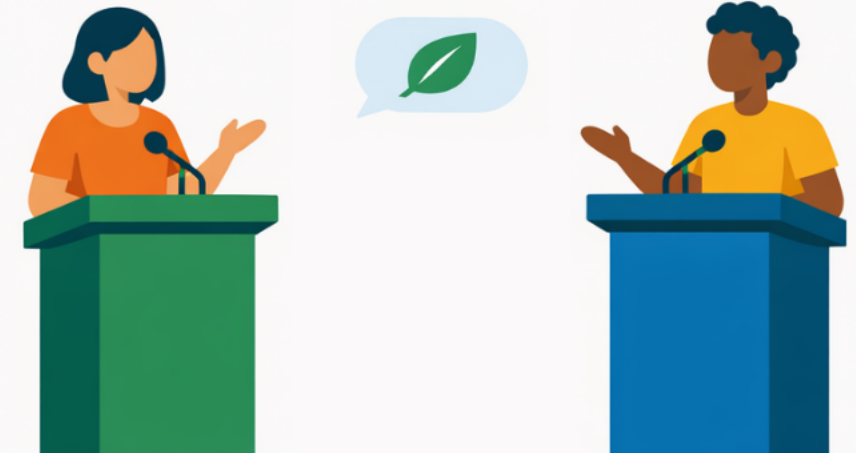


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MOTION: Fossil Fuels are essential for the future of the UK

Balance Glide & Ride

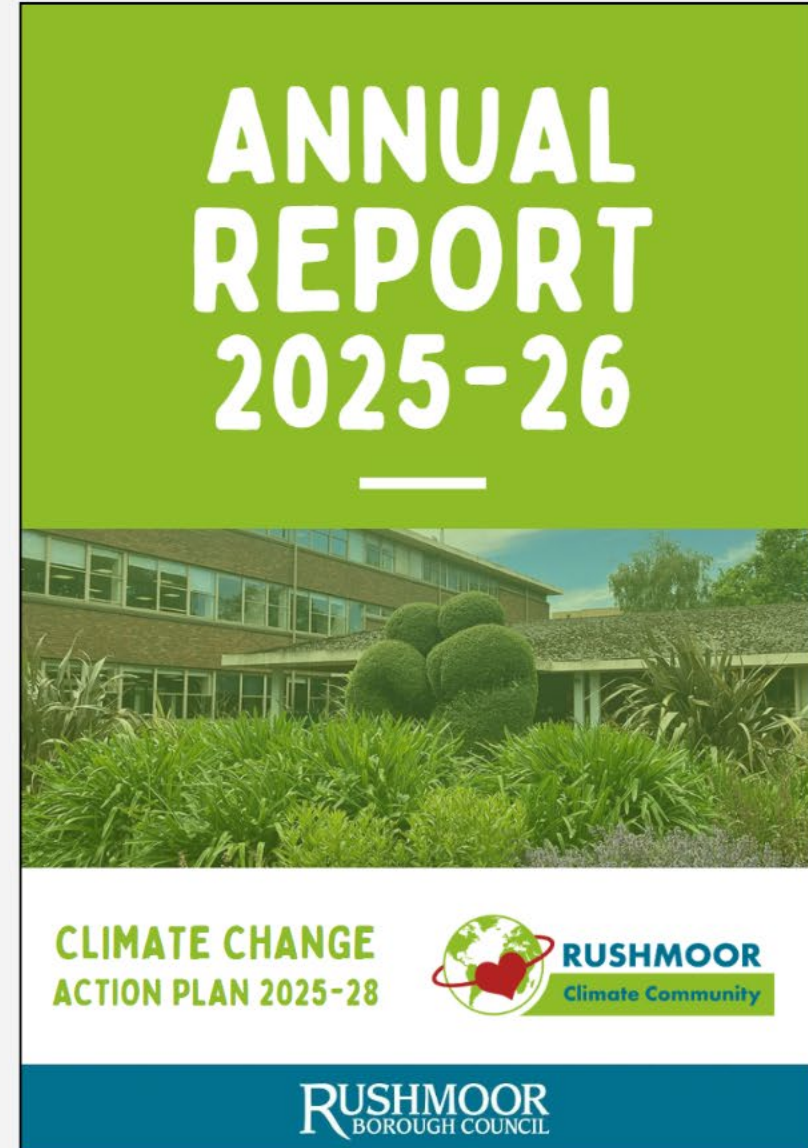
