



## **LICENSING ACT 2003**

**Request to make a recommendation in respect  
of restrictions to access by children to

## **DECISION**

To apply a film classification of PG.

## **REASONS**

The Sub-Committee considered that a PG rating was justified for the following reasons:

- The film contains frequent imagery of guns used in a hunting context.

The Sub-Committee considered that there was a strong focus on the morality of the weapon use and the impact of hunting wild animals. Details of hunting were not dwelt upon.

The Sub-Committee considered the theme of the film appropriate for general viewing however considered that some younger or more sensitive viewers may find elements upsetting.

- The film includes infrequent use of bad language however it was not considered that this was used aggressively.
- There is an incident of a gunshot wound and mild violence however the image of the wound is not dwelt upon.
