DECISION

To grant the licence as applied for.

REASONS

The Sub-Committee heard from:

Aimee Vosser - Rushmoor Licensing Officer

Ms Vosser read the Report to the Committee

Mr Irfan, Director

Mr Irfan made representations on behalf of the applicant including providing the background of property and the business in support of the application. Mr Irfan also explained that they are an established business with a current customer base. During their trading they have not observed any criminal activity within the vicinity of their premises. The premises are close to a police station. Most late night business is deliveries, using cars with two drivers.

Mr Irfan confirmed that the business is a franchise and that the applicant has been in the business for approximately 8 years.

Mr Irfan stated that they have not received any complaints from local residents during their time of trading.

Written Objections

The Sub-Committee considered the written representations made by members of the public. None of the objectors attended the hearing. The Sub-Committee gave consideration to complaints only factual and relevant to the licensing objectives.

The Sub-Committee received legal advice as follows:

- The options available to the Sub-Committee are laid out in the report and the Sub-Committee must consider which option, in its consideration, is reasonable based upon this hearing.
- The decision must be made solely by the Sub-Committee members and only by those Members who have heard the whole application.
- The Sub-Committee must take such steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives;
 - The prevention of crime and disorder
 - Public safety

- The prevention of public nuisance
- The protection of children from harm
- To ensure natural justice, the Sub-Committee should give reasons for its decision.

The Sub-Committee made the following findings of fact:

Applicant has met all the safety, noise and licensing requirements. The applicant has a good trading history without any complaints.
