

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for the review of a Premises Licence

DECISION

To grant the application, allowing the licence to continue, with the existing conditions to the licence, and with the addition to Annex 3 of that licence of the conditions set out at pages 33 to 36 of Exempt Report No. OS2308. This includes a requirement for CCTV coverage of the front of the shop, the side of the shop, the area behind the shop and the interior of the shop.

REASONS

- 1. The Sub-Committee made its decision in consideration of the Licensing Act 2003, the Secretary of State's Guidance issued under section 182 of that Act, and the Rushmoor Borough Council's Statement of Licensing Policy.
- 2. The decision was based upon an appreciation of the likely effect of the granting of the review upon the promotion of the four Licensing Objectives: the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm.
- 3. Each member of the Sub-Committee read and considered the application and accompanying documents and read and considered the late-arriving material from Councillor Vosper and from the Premises Licence Holder.
- 4. The Sub-Committee listened carefully to the representations from the Applicant; to the representations of the Rushmoor Borough Council Licensing Officer, to the representations on behalf of the Premises Licence Holder and the expanded representations from Councillor Vosper.
- 5. It noted that the Applicant and the Premises Licence Holder had agreed the proposed new conditions (reproduced at pages 33-36 of Exempt Report No. OS2308) and noted that neither the Licensing Officer nor any other party had objected to the licence continuing, with the addition of these new conditions.
- 6. The decision of the Sub-Committee is therefore to grant the application, allowing the licence to continue with the existing conditions to the licence, and with the addition to Annex 3 of that licence of the conditions at pages 33-36 of Exempt Report No. OS2308. This includes a requirement for CCTV coverage of the front of the shop, the side of the shop, the area behind the shop and the interior of the shop.
- 7. Any party to the hearing may appeal to the Magistrates' Court in writing, within 21 days of receipt of this written decision.
