DECISION

To adjourn the review hearing until after the application for the transfer of the licence has been determined.

REASONS

In coming to its decision, the Sub-Committee has taken into account:

- The Licensing Act Section 18, which states that, having regard to the application and any relevant representations, the Sub-Committee must take such of the steps available to it as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives;
- The Secretary of State's Guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003;
- The Council's Statement of Licensing Policy 2010 – 2011 and;
- The representations for the Applicant and the Licence Holder.

Having received the notification of the application to transfer the licence with immediate effect shortly before the hearing was due to begin, the Sub-Committee heard the views of whether the parties wished to proceed. Whilst it was possible to proceed with the hearing, the papers did not contain information specifically in relation to the applicant of the transfer. In the interest of procedural fairness and to ensure that full information was available, the Sub-Committee determined that it wished to provide an opportunity for the applicant and licence holder to submit additional evidence having considered the impact of the application to transfer the licence prior to determining the review application.
