1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This report concerns an application to transfer a premises licence made under section 42 of the Licensing Act 2003 (the 'Act'). A representation has been received in respect of the application and invokes a statutory requirement to hold a hearing with members.
- 1.2 The report provides details of, and background to the applications, and should be read in conjunction with the Council's licensing policy and Secretary of State's guidance. This, together with information obtained at the hearing should be used to determine the applications.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 An application to transfer a premises licence was submitted on 3rd March 2026 by NA Pizza Centre Limited in respect of a premises known as Pizza Gogo, 5 Union Street, Aldershot GU11 1EG. A copy of the application is given at **appendix A**
- 2.2 A map of the area showing the general location of the premises is given at **appendix B**.
- 2.3 Advertising of the application**
- 2.4 I can confirm that the responsible authorities, Hampshire Constabulary and Home Office – Immigration enforcement, (as specified in the Act) received a copy of the transfer application. The last date for objections was given as 17th March 2026.

3.0 OBJECTION(S)

- 3.1 An objection notice from Home Office, Immigration enforcement was made in respect of the transfer application. A copy of the objection is given at **appendix C**.

4.0 OTHER DATA PROTECTION ISSUES

- 4.1 In accordance with data protection requirements, any personal details, addresses, contact details and/or signatures submitted on any application, representation or other relevant document etc. have been redacted.

5.0 DETERMINATION

5.1 Further to the receipt of the objection notice and, in accordance with the Act and the Council's scheme of delegation, the Sub-Committee is asked to determine the applications.

6.0 RELEVANT CONSIDERATIONS

6.2 In considering the application the licensing authority must have regard to the prevention of illegal working.

6.3 Licensing Policy and Secretary of States Guidance

6.4 The licensing authority must also have regard to its statement of licensing policy and any guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182 of the Act.

6.6 Human rights

- (a) to transfer the licence as applied for; or
- (b) to refuse the application.

- (c) the Council's licensing policy;

Representations are being made for the following reasons:

Offence, immigration penalty, dates, penalty amount etc.

Immigration Enforcement formally objects to the transfer of a premises licence for Pizza Gogo / Kebabish, located at 5, Union Street, Aldershot, GU11 1EG.

The request to transfer the Premises licence was made before a review hearing on 03 March 2026, by Qazi Khan DARWESH, who transferred the Premises licence to NA Pizza Centre Limited, Company Number 16564470.

This objection is based on serious concerns regarding the management and operation of the premises, and clear links between the old and new directors of the premises, as detailed below.

The Current Director of NA Pizza Centre Limited, Company Number 16564470, is Nisar Ahmad NEARY, who incorporated the company on 07 July 2025. NEARY also became director of NA KEBABISH LIMITED (17008546), when this business was incorporated on 03 February 2026.

The address for both companies is 5 and 5a, Union Street, Aldershot, GU11 1EG. This is the same as the current premises of Pizza GoGo and Kebabish, for which we have already requested a hearing to review the premises licence.

Home Office Checks.

At the last review hearing of 03 March 2026, the Legal representative who attended on behalf of the premises licence holders, stated there was no links between the new proposed owner, and the old.

The Home Office Licensing Compliance team have carried out immigration checks for the new proposed licence holder, Nisar Ahmad NEARY and any other names listed in the previous review pack, to show the family links.

Nisar Ahmad NEARY, DOB 24 February 2008, is recorded as a (GBR) British Citizen, on Home Office systems, and is recorded as initially holding an alias name of Nisar Ahmad NEAZY, an (AFG) Afghanistan National.

On 07 October 2017 NEAZY (son) was Granted British Citizen under the section 3(1) of the British Nationality Act 1981, having been sponsored by his Parent / Responsible adult, known to the Home Office as Ghulam Husain NEAZY, DOB 01 January 1985, who is recorded as a British Citizen on Home Office systems from 26 February 2014, having attended his Naturalisation ceremony.



Immigration Enforcement

On the 07 February 2018 the British passport was issued to a Nisar Ahmad **NEARY**, DOB 24 February 2008, which records the name change from **NEAZY** to **NEARY**. Home Office systems also recorded as a parent on this application as Ghulam Husain NEAZY. Nisar Ahmed NEARY, has also been issued with a British Passport in May 2023, and has his address stated as 33 Manor Road, Aldershot, GU11 3DG, recorded on Home Office systems.

This is a clear link with new formed director Nisar Ahmed NEARY, the proposed new owner of the premises licence, as the son of Ghulam Hussain NEAZY, the current director, and one connected to the business, and also linked to Qazi Khan DARWESH, the previous premises licence holder.

Qazi Khan DARWESH, is also connected to both AM PIZZA CENTRE LIMITED - Company number 14301753 and TASTY KEBABISH LIMITED - Company number 14304254 having resigned from both companies on 01 June 2025, once a civil penalty was received from illegal working on the premises.

Ghulam Hussain NEAZY, then became director of both AM PIZZA CENTRE LIMITED - Company number 14301753 and TASTY KEBABISH LIMITED - Company number 14304254, on 01 June 2025, after DARWESH resigned.

Therefore, on the balance of probabilities, this premises licence transfer, is likely to have been completed only minutes before our review hearing, to avoid action being taken by the Home Office to prevent further crime and disorder in the premises, in regard to the previous illegal working, for which both NEAZY and DARWESH have refused to take any responsibility whilst they run this premises.

It is believed that the effective control of this premises will remain with NEAZY and DARWESH who are named within our initial application to review the premises licence.

It is considered that the prevention of crime and disorder objective would be prejudiced if the application is allowed. The Home Office objects to the transfer of the premises licence to Nisar Ahmed NEARY.

IE objects to the grant of an application for the transfer of a premises licence to the applicant.

Reasons for which there is a risk to the licensing objectives, and why the objection is appropriate to prevent crime including illegal working in licensed premises.
