1.0 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. This report concerns an application for a premises licence made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 (the 'Act'). Representations have been received in respect of the application and invoke a statutory requirement to hold a hearing with members.
- 1.2. The report provides details of, and background to the application, and should be read in conjunction with the Council's licensing policy and Secretary of State's guidance. This, together with information obtained at the hearing should be used to determine the application.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1. An application for premises licence was submitted on 19th December 2018 by SK PVT Limited, in respect of the premises at 58 Station Road, Aldershot, GU11 1BG.
- 2.2. A map of the area showing the general location of the premises is given at **appendix A**.

2.3. Nature of the application

- 2.4. The application seeks to apply for the sale of alcohol on Monday's to Thursday's 12:00(midday) to 22:00pm and on Friday's to Sunday's 12:00(midday) to 23:00pm.
- **2.5.** A copy of the application form is given at **appendix B.**

2.6. Advertising of the application

2.7. I can confirm that each responsible authority (as specified in the Act) has received a copy of the application. I can also confirm that the application was advertised by the applicant in accordance with the requirements of the legislation both at the premises and in a local newspaper. The last date for representations was given as the 16th January 2019.

3.0 REPRESENTATIONS

3.3. One representation by way of an objection has been received in respect of this application. This representation has been made by a responsible authority, namely The Licensing Authority. A copy of the representation is given at **appendix C**.

3.4. Relevance of Representation(s)

- 3.5. To be eligible to be considered, the Act requires a(ny) representation(s) to be 'relevant'. A 'relevant representation' is one that has been made by a responsible authority or any other person within the prescribed period permitted. Similarly, representations must not be frivolous or vexatious and must be about the likely effect of the grant of the licence on the promotion of the licensing objectives.
- 3.6. The licensing objectives are defined in the Act and include -
 - (a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
 - (b) ensuring public safety;
 - (c) the prevention of public nuisance; and
 - (d) the protection of children from harm.

3.7. Relevance of representations

3.8. Against the above criteria the representations are considered to be relevant as they were submitted within the prescribed period, by a responsible authority and concern all four of the licensing objectives; namely the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, protection of children from harm and public nuisance.

4.0 DATA PROTECTION ISSUES

4.3. As a public document, any personal details, including addresses, contact details and/or signatures submitted on any application, representation or other document contained in this report have been redacted in accordance with data protection requirements.

5.0 DETERMINATION

5.3. Further to the receipt of relevant representations and, in accordance with the Act and the Council's scheme of delegation, the Sub-Committee is asked to determine the application.

6.0 RELEVANT CONSIDERATIONS

6.3. Licensing Objectives

6.4. In determination of the application, the licensing authority must have regard to the promotion of the licensing objectives. These are set out at paragraph 3.6 above.

6.5. Licensing policy & S182 Guidance

6.6. The licensing authority must also have regard to its statement of licensing policy and any guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182 of the Act. Details of the parts of the policy and guidance that may be relevant to this application are given in **appendix D** to this report.

7.0 OPTIONS

- 7.3. In determining this application, the Sub-Committee may take any of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives; namely -
 - (a) to grant the licence as applied for*; or
 - (b) to reject the whole or part of the application.
 - * Subject to any relevant mandatory conditions, amendments agreed by the applicant and/or such other conditions that are consistent with the operating schedule which, with the exception of mandatory conditions, may be modified (which may include the alteration or omission of a condition or the addition of any new condition(s)) to such extent as may be necessary to promote the licensing objectives.

- 8.3. The Sub-Committee is asked to determine the application having regard to -
 - (a) the contents of this report;
 - (b) any additional information obtained from the hearing;
 - (c) the Council's licensing policy;







I also have 18 months experience as an Investigator for Gangmaster Labour and Abuse Authority and 12 years experience as a Police Officer. I hold a BIIAB National Certificate for Personal Licence holders, a BIIAB National Certificate for Licensing Practitioners and a BIIAB National Certificate for Licensing Practitioners (Gambling).

Capacity and authority of individual making representations:

I am making this representation in the capacity and embodiment of a responsible authority as defined in Section 13(4) of the Licensing Act 2003 (as amended by Section 103 of the Police Reform & Social Responsibility Act 2011). Nature and grounds of representation:

The promotion of the licensing objectives at licensed premises relies on licence holders, and DPS's having a good knowledge of the relevant legislation, and ensuring compliance with the relevant terms and conditions of the premises licence. The previous premises licence for this Restaurant lapsed on 14th August 2018, when the company who held the licence was dissolved.

The Restaurant continued to operate and sell alcohol until 14th December 2018 when Licensing Officers attended and stopped the sale of alcohol taking place. The provision of licensable activities without the requisite licence is a criminal offence, and this is currently still under investigation, and will be dealt with separately from the current licence application.

However, the above raises significant concerns as to the licence holder and DPS's regard for compliance with legislation and the promotion of the licensing objectives, as well as their knowledge and understanding of the requirements. Currently I have little confidence in the management of the premises.
