#### Last PPAB meeting to consider UKSPF (13 July 2022)

- PPAB received an introduction to the UKSPF and a briefing on how the funding could be used.
- PPAB were updated on the progress that had been made on longlisting and identifying potential interventions for inclusion in the Investment Plan
- PPAB provided feedback on the following shortlisting criteria:
  - Is it a priority in the Council Plan/existing strategies?
  - Are we doing it already, or can someone else deliver it?
  - Support from residents/businesses/stakeholders/elected Members
  - Will the project deliver tangible benefits?
  - Will the project incur additional cost for the Council now or in the future?

In addition PPAB also advised that the following areas should be considered as the Investment Plan is developed: a) Community/voluntary/ward grants to support neighbourhood level projects; b) Youth engagement; c) Supporting town centres; d) Ongoing community/stakeholder engagement

#### What's changed since then?

- Delay in confirming UKSPF Investment Plans received December 2022
- Council's financial position and Outcomes Based Budgeting Exercise
- Confirmation of the Levelling Up Fund for Farnborough Town Centre
- Through the Annual Residents Survey, we have started to undertake some initial benchmarking for monitoring and evaluation purposes

• Unfortunately, there hasn't been any change to the allocations by year - £34k in 2022/23, £68k in 2023/24 and £898k in 2024/25

- **Place Branding** £15,000 To deliver place narratives and branding for Farnborough and Aldershot Town Centres as recommended in the Farnborough Town Centre Strategy
